Some of the events will be:

- The authentic Field course consists of many and various Targets ranging from Old style paper to current 3 D and some new 2D targets.
 - Target distances range from 8 to 36 mtrs
 - Rolling disc. 30 sec and 60 sec speed rounds
 - The Infamous White Rose Windmill
 - The Carp Shoot – A Challenge round with a difference
 - Night event
 - 3 little pigs and a Wolf along with Dinosaurs

- The range of 20 targets vary from vinyl, 2D and 3D animals is surrounded by 24 acres of grape vines, many orange trees, and pear trees
 - The Rolling disk is set by the orange trees and you shoot from inside the shed, the window of shooting is about 2.7 mtrs wide.
 - Camping is available at Irymple with first in best camp spot. There is a caravan park down the road, in walking distance
 - To make life easier for everyone, you will need to be self-sufficient. Take Away is just down the road
 - There will be 3 bbqs at Roadies' for people to use.
 - As we are affiliated with TAA any members who are travelling this way are welcome to come and shoot, please remember we are a TRADITIONAL KLUB. Only Longbows, Recurves and Asiatic (horse bow), Selfbows/ELB with wood arrows and feathers to suit.
 - Shoot Fees is \$25 for the weekend and looking to head out to the range around 9.00amish
 - The club members will be made fully aware of, and be compliant with, the Vic State Government legislation, Federal Government legislation and any TAA advice.
 - If you are unwell, please do not attend.
 - Only outdoor club activities will operate.
 - Hand sanitiser will be available. It is recommended you also have your own handwashing and sanitiser.
 - Archers to practice safe hygiene at all times, including washing hands for at least 20 seconds before and after any archery activity.
 - The numbers will be restricted for the social gatherings as set by State Government.
 - Archery equipment should not be shared between archers.
 - Archers to maintain social distancing at all times.
 - Each archer will retrieve their own arrows from the target.
