- 2x15 (minimum) Target Field Course consisting of many and various targets ranging from Old Style ABA Targets, 2D Targets and 3D Targets, to be shot both days.
- 3 Arrows at each target all scoring on Saturday.
- Target distances from 8 to 36 Metres
- Novelties:
 - 60 Second Speed Round.
 - Moving Target.
 - Rolling Discs.
 - The Infamous White Rose Windmill.
 - The Carp Shoot- a challenge round with a difference – 30 second speed round.
 - Three little pigs and a wolf with Dinosaurs as well.

- The new ranges are surrounded by 10,000 acres of open paddock.
- The novelty events will be set up not too far from the camping area.
- Camping available from Thursday through to Tuesday (if required)
- There is no power.
- You will need to be totally self-sufficient for all meals, toilet and shower facilities (at this stage as this is a recent move and set up, so no home comforts)
- White Rose Archery Klub is affiliated with TAA, any members who are travelling this way are welcome to come and shoot, please remember we are a TRADITIONAL KLUB. Only longbows, Recurves and Asiatic (horse bows), Selbows/ELB. Wood arrows with feathers to suit.

- The new range can be found on Castle Crossing Road, Carwarp Vic. 20 minutes along the Calder Highway from Red Cliffs (which is out from Mildura).
- Turn right onto Castle Crossing Road, go over railway line about 200m on your left is a sign reading T & J Gowers 'Newhaven' turn left here. Inside the gate look over to your left and you will see the container and a new road has been pushed through. You have arrived!
